Dear Friends and Family,

As many of you are familiar with, we had to cut our time in Portugal short. Various factors were considered when making this decision including our visa expiration date, Baby's due date, and the processing time of receiving documents such as Baby's passport and our visas for Mozambique. We made the lengthy 23-hour journey to MAF's headquarters (HQ) in Nampa, Idaho, at the end of October. We'll be staying here as we await Baby's arrival and our required documents to travel to Mozambique in 2021. Elias has been enjoying running around outside and having other kids to play with here at HQ. We have been enjoying the blessings of a supportive church family nearby who arranged meals for us during the first few days of our transition back to the US.

Leaving Portugal at this time shouldn't affect our timeline and preparations for arriving in Mozambique too much. Ryan is continuing his Portuguese language classes with the University of Coimbra via Zoom through January, and I (Annabel) am continuing self-study until Baby is born. Upon Baby's arrival, we will begin the processes necessary to obtain his birth certificate, his passport, Ryan's work permit, and our visas. These processes will likely take a few months and, due to the COVID-related processing delays, we are unsure of when we can expect to be leaving for our new home in Mozambique. Ryan and I are praying to be ready for departure in March or April of 2021.

In the meantime, we'll be living in Idaho where Ryan will be attending trainings at HQ to better prepare him for service in Mozambique. It is our desire to use the skills that we have acquired to serve Christ and further the Gospel in this country we'll be calling home. After almost two years of preparation, we are thrilled to finally be so close to our departure. The anticipation of seeing first-hand the light of Christ shining in the darkness of a country in need of hope fills us with joy! Your participation in this ministry through prayers and support have been vital and are greatly appreciated!
